IEEE COMSOC Student Travel Grants

The IEEE INFOCOM 2006 organizing committee is pleased to announce the availability of Student Travel Grants, sponsored by the *IEEE Communications Society*. Applications are invited from qualified graduate students. Around five awards are expected.

Eligibility

IEEE Communications Society will award a limited number of Student Travel Grants to full-time engineering students. To qualify you must:

1. Be a valid member of at the time of application
2. Live outside the Region where this conference will take place (Region8);
3. Be an author who will present an accepted paper at this Conference;
4. Not have received a similar grant in the past 12 months; and
5. Provide all of the information below.

Grant Benefits

Grants consist of a check for \$1000 (U.S.).

How to apply

An application for a travel award will consist of:

1. A letter from the student, including paper title if paper has been accepted for INFOCOM 2006,
2. The student's vita, and,
3. A supporting letter from the student's graduate advisor.

The letter from the student should include:

1. A brief summary of research interests and accomplishments to date,
2. A description of areas reflected in the INFOCOM 2006 program that would impact the student's research, and,
3. A statement about why the conference attendance is important to the student.

The advisor's recommendation letter to the committee should include:

1. Confirmation that the student is a bona-fide Ph.D. or M.S. candidate in good standing,
2. The suitability of the INFOCOM 2006 program material to the student's research area,
3. Ways this particular student would benefit from attendance at the conference, and,
4. The strengths and potential contributions of the student.

2. Advisors should send their recommendation letters by email, to the same address above (infocom06-grants@ac.upc.edu).
